## **Active Implementation**



## **01. Identify patients**

Spirit nurse carries out audit on GP Practice clinical system to identify patients suitable for review. This will identify patients prescribed leg or night bags, ISC or sheaths.

#### 02. Notes review and changes

Spirit Nurse reviews patient records to establish groups for the reviews.

#### 03. GP approval

GP reviews and approves patient list. GP will identify and flag any additional ad hoc exclusions e.g. under care of specialist, mental health etc. These patients may have their appliances reviewed at another appointment.

#### **04. Product review**

Identified patients will have their current appliances reviewed in line with the local formulary by telephone appointment.

#### **05. Product review outcome**

Current product reviewed and either

Changed to reflect local formulary
Stopped if no longer required
Quantities changed to reflect clinical need

• Referred to specialist





## 06. Product update

The Spirit Nurse recommendations will be discussed with the patient lead GP who will then authorise the changes made to their treatment plan

#### 07. Communication to patients

Spirit Nurses send letters to the authorised patients to notify them of the changes to their prescription.

#### **08. Prescription change**

The patients prescription is changed over to the new products.
